We are looking for trainers and consultants who have the motivation and the skills to bring about big changes in factories and want to make a business out of providing training and consulting services. To apply to become a SCORE trainer, you must meet the following criteria:



Essential criteria

- Capacity to sell SCORE training to enterprises
- Effective at training adults. Including strong presentation and facilitation skills
- Degree in a relevant topic. Including, but not limited to, engineering, human resource management, business administration, or food science
- Knowledge and significant experience of management or consulting in at least two of the following areas:
 - o Production and productivity improvement
 - Quality
 - Human resources
 - Occupational Safety and Health
 - Food safety
- Capacity to persuade staff at all levels to make changes and to communicate technical information in a simple and clear way
- High level of analytic capacity. Including capacity to collect, analyse and interpret data, and to identify key problems within factories
- Problem solving skills and systematic approach to problem-solving
- High level of competence in word and excel

Desirable criteria

- High level management experience in factories and experience of managing change in organisations
- Capacity to communicate effectively in English (written and spoken)
