





Indonesia National Recommendations for the 13th ASEAN Forum on Migrant Labour

22 October 2020

Supporting migrant workers during the pandemic for a Cohesive and Responsive ASEAN

Community

Sub-theme 1: Impact of COVID-19 on migrant workers and responses in ASEAN

- 1. Creating a roadmap in handling the migrant worker who are impacted by Covid 19 which includes the states strategy for the long-term plan in absorbing the employment (domestic and overseas)
- 2. The government creates a framework on force majeure which includes bilateral and regional cooperation
- 3. Formulating the responsibilities which to be carried out by the receiving countries, should any termination occurs during the pandemic/epidemic period (the follow up action on regulation no.1/2020 concerning the Indonesian migrant workers working contract standard, signing, and verification
- 4. To have participation from public and other stakeholders' in ensuring the rights fulfilment of the migrant workers during the pandemic/epidemic period

Sub-theme 2: Inclusive and responsive labour migration policy for future preparedness in ASEAN

- 5. To form a regional coordination body and mechanism comprises of national leading agency such as BNPB to have a regional contingency plan especially on migration under one specific task force in order to come up with an emergency protocol that using human rights based approaches
- 6. It has to be designed under tripartite and inclusive mechanism, including the participation of women migrant workers.
- 7. The said protocol will cover regional cooperation to end discrimination and stigma toward migrant workers, end criminalization and deportation, , providing portable health care, including health test, medical assistance, accessible social safety net, etc
