## Reports of the Officers of the Governing Body

## Arrangements for the 15th Asian Regional Meeting

- **1.** At its 307th Session (March 2010), the Governing Body approved the proposal to hold the 15th Asian Regional Meeting from 12 to 15 October 2010, in Bangkok, Thailand.
- **2.** In light of the present political situation in Thailand, the Office recently held consultations with the Government of Thailand, with a view to assessing the viability of proceeding with the planned arrangements for the timing and venue of the Asian Regional Meeting, taking into account security and related concerns.
- **3.** Based on these consultations, and considering the extraordinary circumstances, the Director-General recommends that the venue of the meeting be moved from Thailand to another country in Asia and that the Office approach interested countries for an alternative venue.
- **4.** Taking into account the ILO official calendar of meetings, it is proposed that the Asian Regional Meeting be rescheduled for three and a half days in April 2011.
- 5. The Officers of the Governing Body recommend that the 15th Asian Regional Meeting be rescheduled in April 2011 and that the Director-General be authorized to approach interested countries for an alternative venue.
